Female:	41%

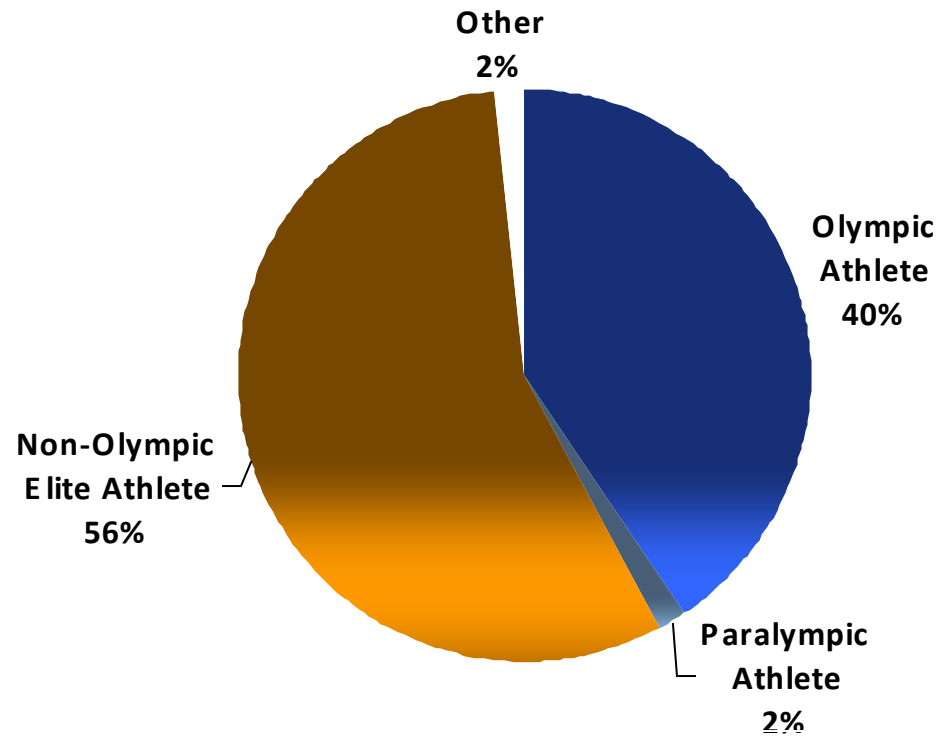

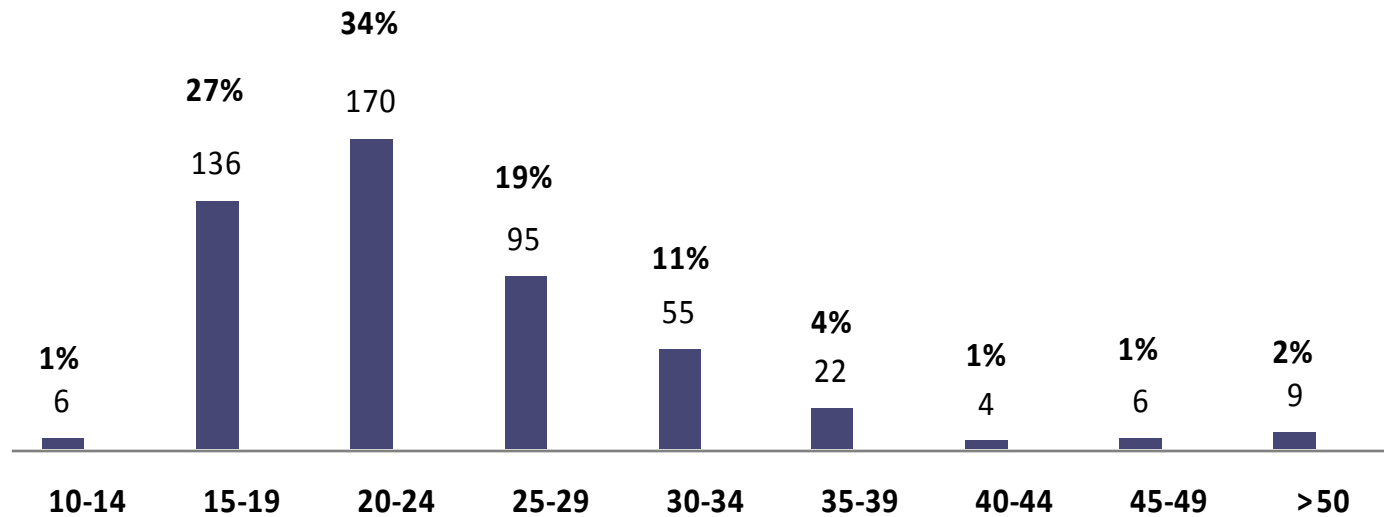

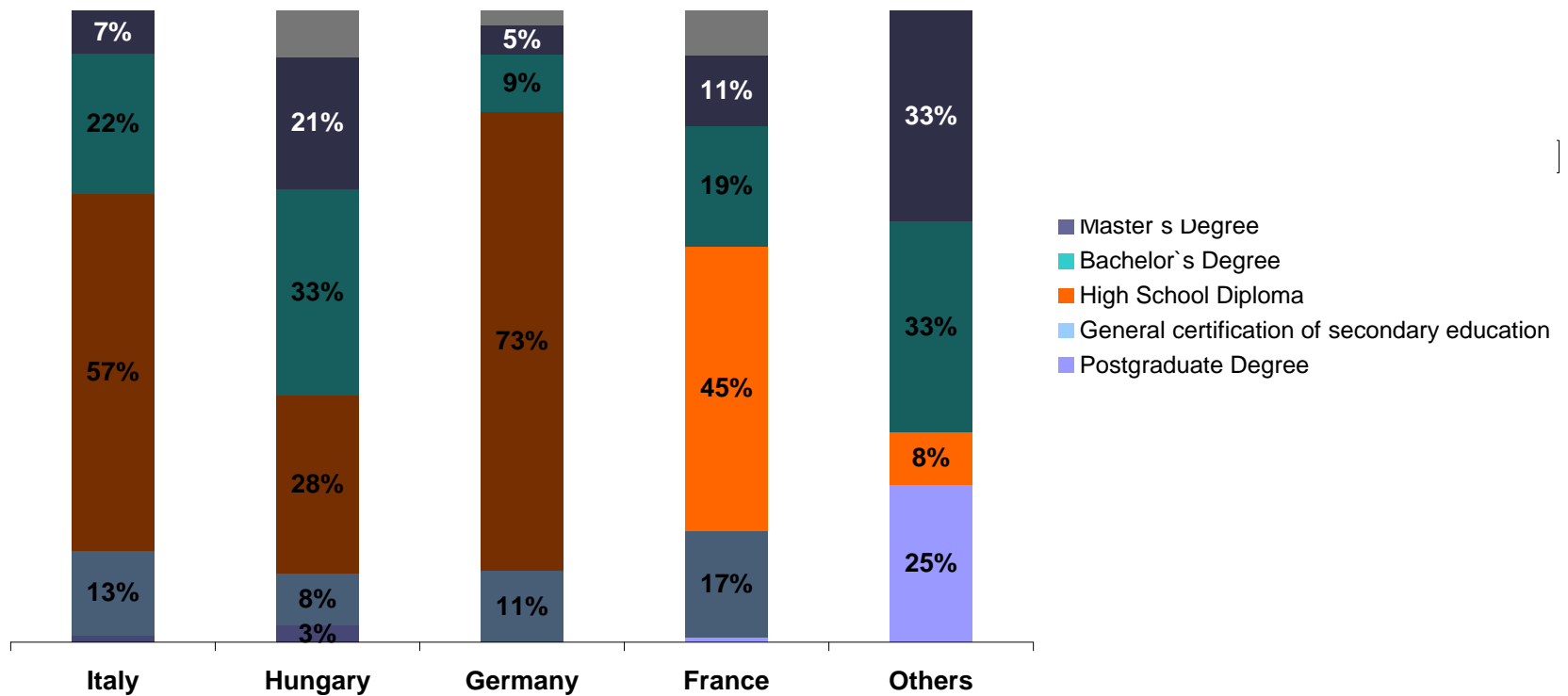

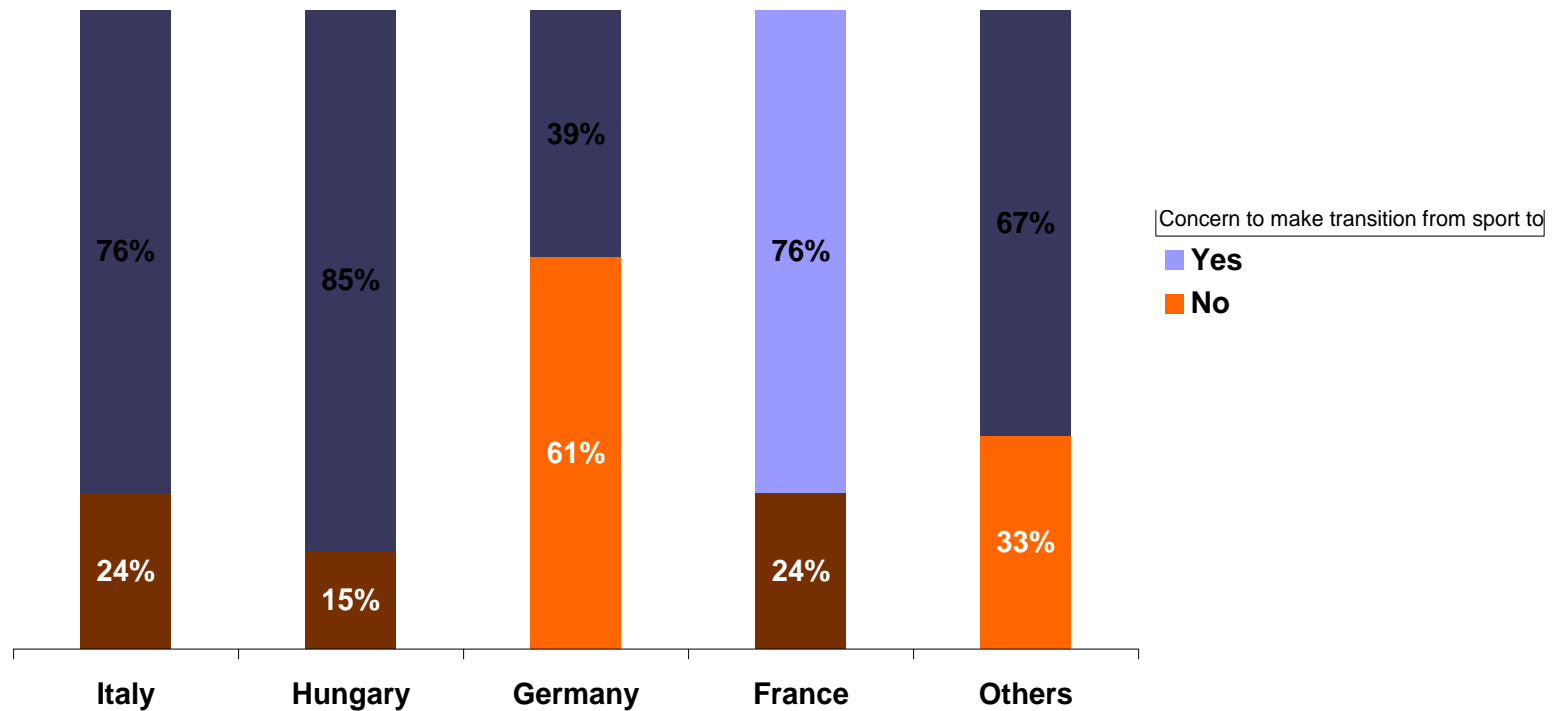

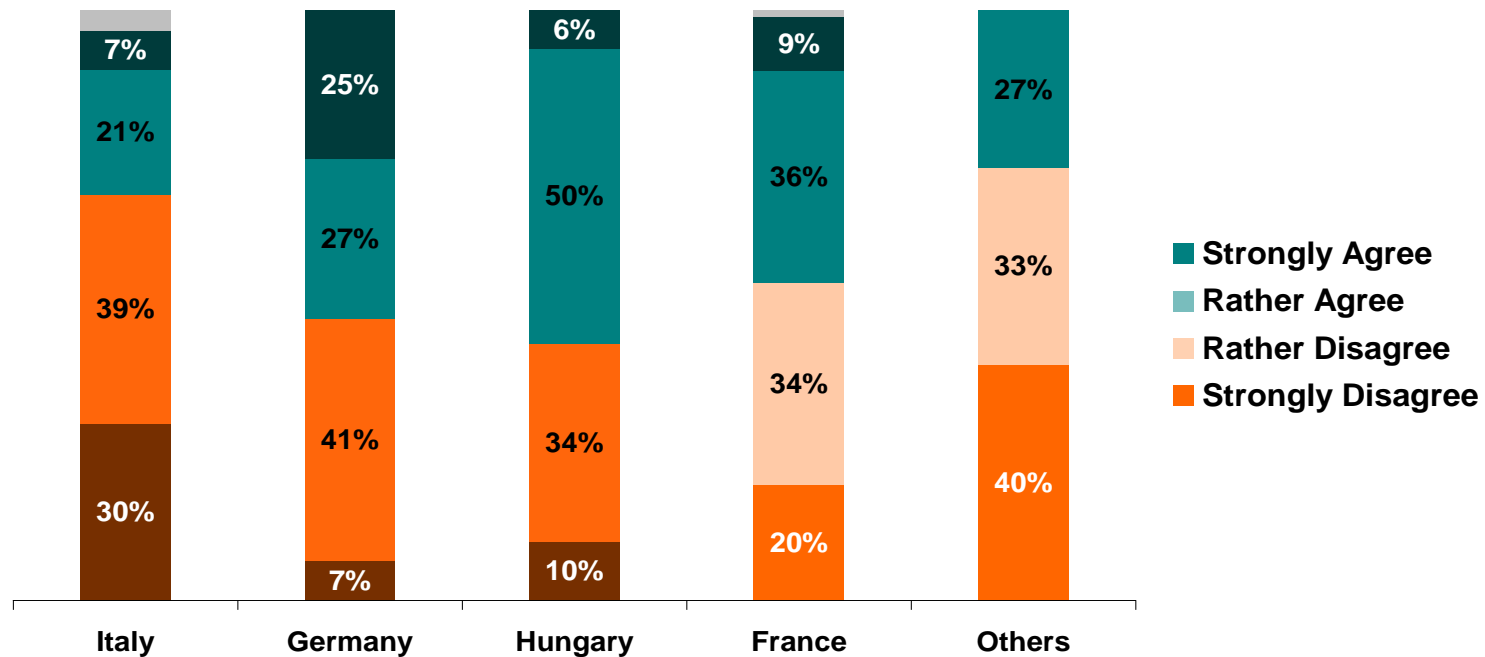

“My sporting activities suffer/ have suffered due to my educational career.”

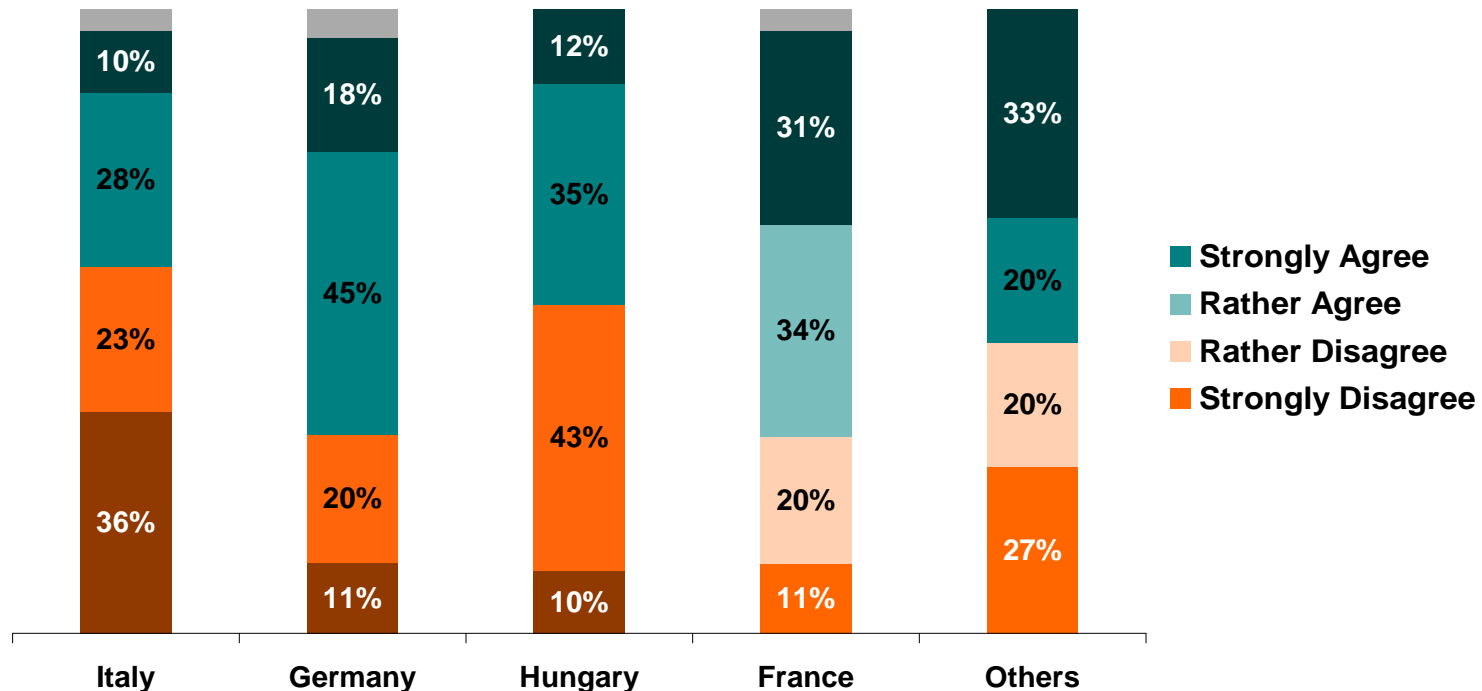

“My school or university helps/ have helped me to combine sports and education.”



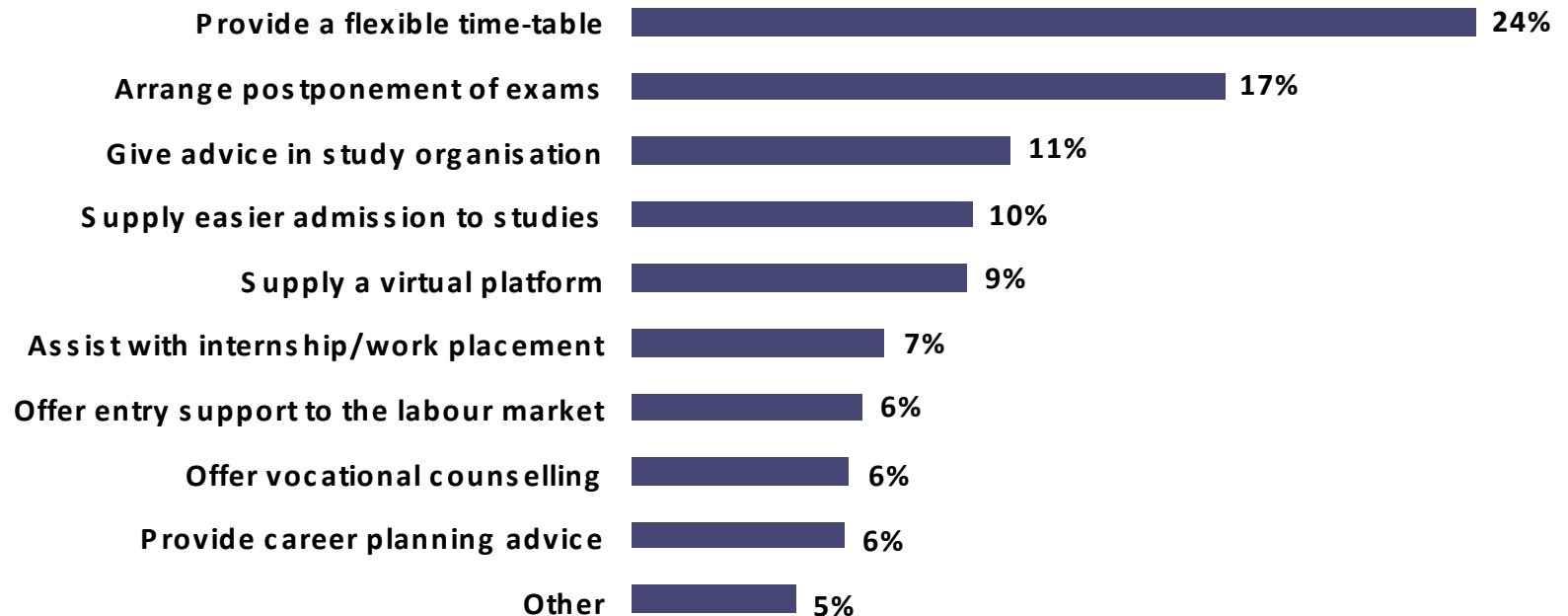

N=1329



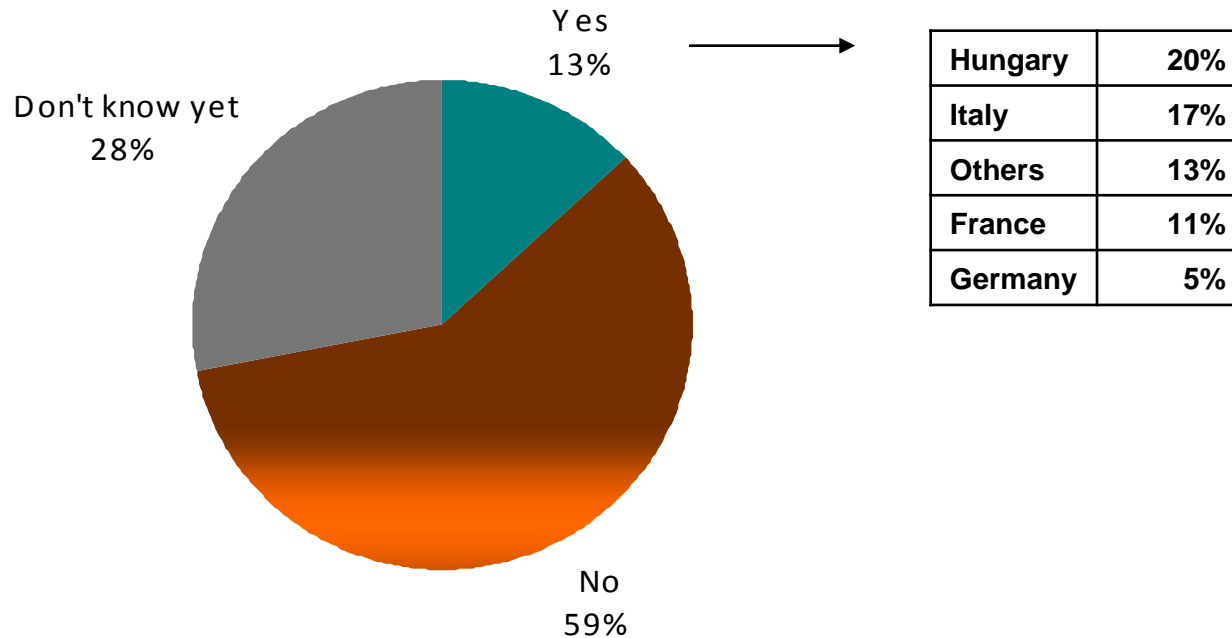

N=633



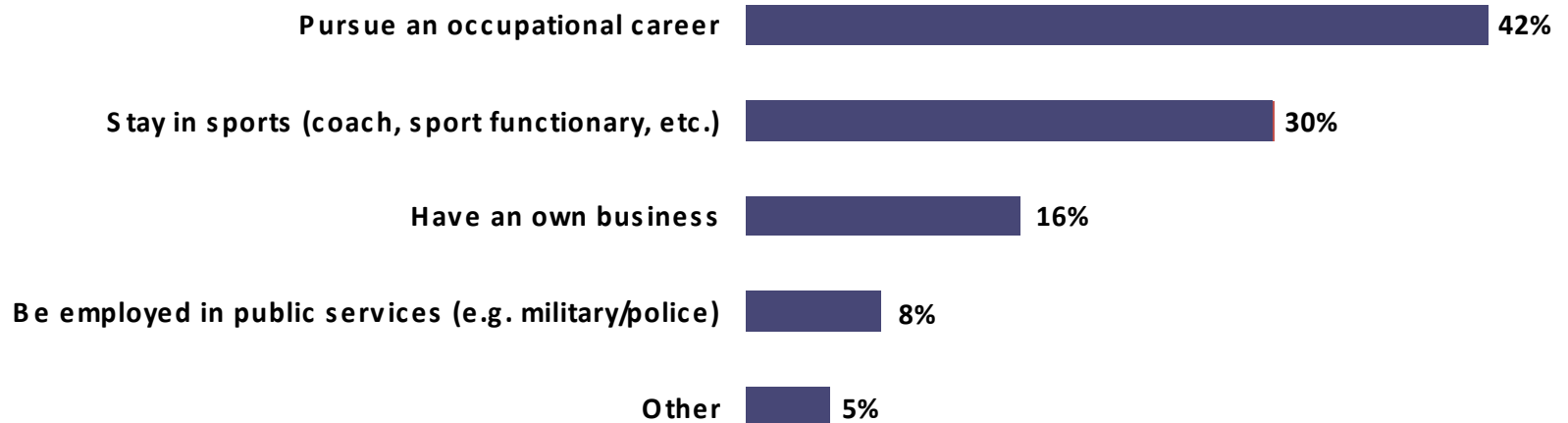

N=822 (multiple answers)

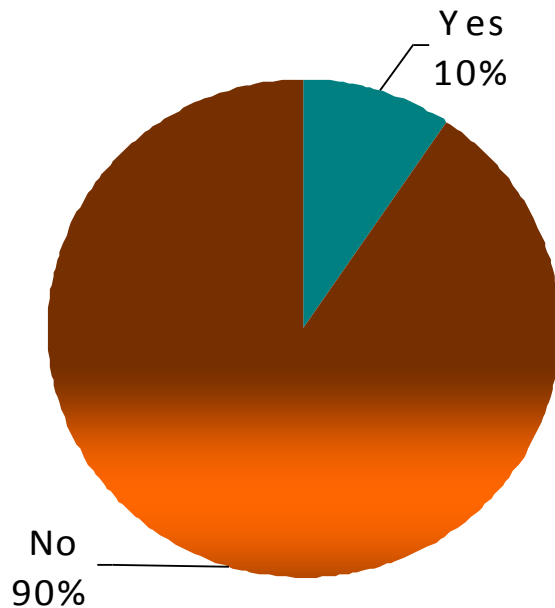

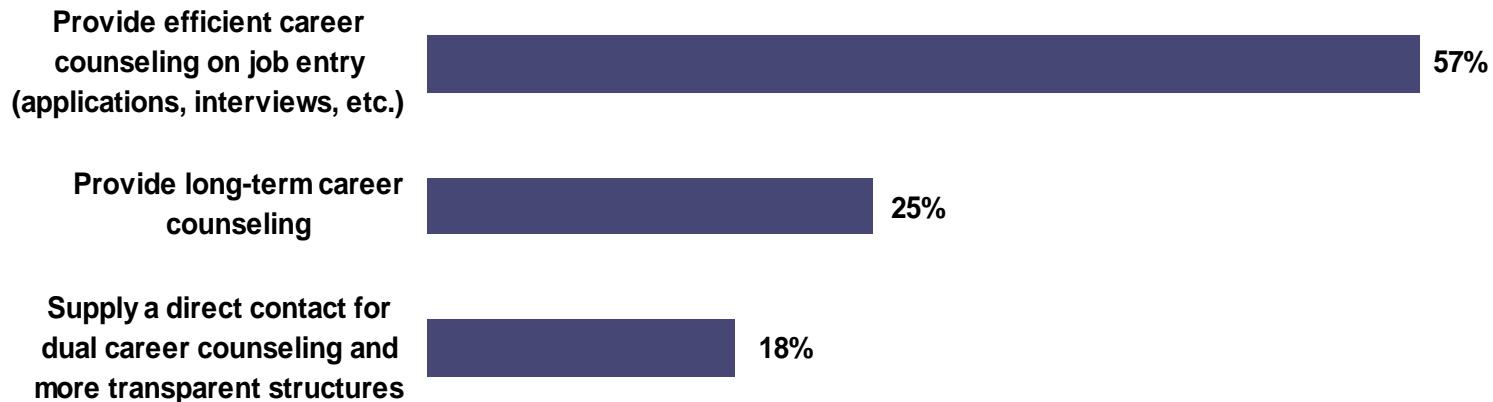
